

At close, the Sensex was up 147.79 points or 0.20 percent at 75,449.05, and the Nifty was up 73.30 points or 0.32 percent at 22,907.60. About 2894 shares advanced, 988 shares declined, and 110 shares unchanged.

At the close of the NYSE, the Dow Jones Industrial Average lost 0.62%, closing at 41,581, while the S&P 500 index declined by 1.07%, closing at 5,615 and the NASDAQ Composite index lost 1.71%, ending at 17,504.

On the Multi-Commodity Exchange (MCX) gold futures contracts made another lifetime high of Rs 88,969/10 grams, silver contracts rose at Rs 1,01,413/kg, up by 0.14% or Rs 144.

U.S. West Texas Intermediate crude futures lost 15 cents, or 0.2%, to \$66.75 a barrel. Brent futures were down 12 cents, or 0.2%, at \$70.44 a barrel.

The rupee ended 12 paise higher at 86.44 per dollar and close of 86.56.

The 06.79 GS 2034 bond opened at 6.6633, reached a high of 6.6462, a low of 6.6647, and closed at 6.6601.
